The Cayman Monetary Regulatory Authority International (CMRAI) hereby notifies you that it has received a new Notice from the Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation, HM Treasury (OFSI), which is attached as an Annex to this Notice. 2. What you must do: A. In the case of an addition or amendment of a person to the Consolidated List and asset freeze: i. Check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the OFSI Notice; ii. Freeze any such accounts and other funds or economic resources. iii. Refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Governor. iv. Report any findings to the Financial Reporting Authority (FRA) at together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the relevant legislative requirements. v. Provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons to the FRA at and submitting a compliance reporting form. Information reported to FRA may be passed to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement. B. In the case of the removal of a person from the Consolidated List and unfreezing of assets i. Check whether you have frozen assets of any person or entity removed from the Consolidated List and verify that the person is no longer subject to an asset freeze. ii. Remove the person from your institution s list of persons or entities subject to financial sanction. iii. Un-freeze the assets of the person and where necessary re-activate all relevant accounts. iv.
